Board Chair, John Dunn, called the regular monthly Board Meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. on April 8, 2020. Due to Oregon Executive Order No. 20-12, the April 8th Board meeting was conducted by electronic communication. The Board Meeting was broadcast by Zoom® Meeting.

Consideration of the minutes of the Regular Monthly Board Meeting of Wednesday, March 11, 2020.

David Campos moved to approve the minutes for the Wednesday, March 11, 2020 Roseburg Urban Sanitary Authority Regular Monthly Meeting.

2020-2021 Budget

Citycounty Insurance Services announced the Health Care Insurance rates for 2021. The overall rate increase for RUSA's coverage will be 4.9%.

The increase of 4.9% is significantly less that the Board's directive to hold the Health Care Insurance rate increase to 6% or less.

Finance Department

A large sector of the Roseburg area work force is not able to work due to the coronavirus pandemic, many utilities are waiving late fees to accommodate consumers. This has been done to reduce the struggling during the coronavirus pandemic.

Staff recommended that the Board approve waiving the late payment fee of \$5.00 per EDU that was reflected on the April 1 Billing upon request, and suspend late fees in the months moving forward until the Governor lifts the workplace restrictions included in her executive orders.

Kelsey Wood made a motion to waive current late fees upon request and upcoming late fees during the duration of the workplace restrictions by Executive Order.

David Campos seconded the motion.

The motion was passed with a 4/0 vote.

RUSA has a policy to turn over unpaid sewer service fees that are more than four months delinquent. In the last few years there has been an increase in customers that have brought their account current in April, May and June after being notified that the unpaid balance will be assessed turnover fees and sent to the County to be placed as a tax lien. Many of these customers may be affected by the workplace restrictions due to the coronavirus pandemic.

Staff would recommend that the Board suspend the policy to impose the Tax Lien Turnovers for the 2019-2020 delinquent accounts.

General Managers Report

Winchester Pump Station Force Main Replacement Project

The contractor is continuing to install the dual force main.

The Contractor has completed approximately 95% of the sanitary sewer work. The project completion is estimated to be in May 2020.

FEMA Application for Damage Claimed Disaster Relief

RUSA has received payment for Project Worksheet (PW) 00042 and PW 00050 for a total reimbursement of \$32,557.33. We have one PW pending for tree removal at the NTS. The contractor's bid for the work is \$64,500, we will be receiving \$60,864.85 in reimbursement from FEMA.

Hooker Road Rehabilitation Project

The project is under design with 50% plans scheduled to be completed in April. The tentative schedule is to put the project out for bidding in June with construction to begin in July or August.

Jacobs Plant Operations Report

Jade Mecham reported the treatment facility averaged 87% BOD removal and 98% Total Suspended Solids removal during February. The total Effluent flow was 105.44 million gallons.

Accounts Payable

The Board reviewed the Accounts Payable Report and Addendum for the April, 2020 Accounts Payable.

Winchester Pump Station Force Main Replacement Project

The Contractor has completed the installation of the new force mains. The contractor has been cleaning and testing the pipe.

The Contractor needs to complete installing a section of gravity sewer, a manhole and make the final connection of the new force mains to the pump stations.

The project completion date is May 31, 2020.

FEMA Application for Damage Claimed Disaster Relief

The Contractor has completed the tree removal at the NTS. We have submitted a pay request to the State. The contractor's bid for the work is \$64,500, we will be receiving \$60,864.85 in reimbursement from FEMA.

Hooker Road Rehabilitation Project

The project is under design with 50% plans scheduled to be completed in May. The tentative schedule is to put the project out for bidding in July with construction to begin in August.

Douglas Avenue Project

The City of Roseburg is in the design phase for the reconstruction of Douglas Avenue from Rifle Range Street to Patterson Street. We have completed a condition assessment of the gravity sewer pipes and manholes within the construction limits and decided to replace the gravity sewer system as part of this project. Century West is the engineering firm working on the project for the City and we have asked them to provide a scope of work and a not to exceed price to include RUSA's work in the design.

The funding for this project has not been identified by the City yet but the 100% design date was moved up to ensure that the City would have a shovel ready project ready if stimulus funding is available due to COVID-19.

Administration Building Improvements

We have hired RENCO General Contractors to add a sidewalk from the side exit of the building to the parking lot to provide a second ADA compliant exit route.

We have received bids to enclose the west porch area and plan on completing the construction in July. This area has become a security issue due to the homeless utilizing the area to sleep and charge their phones.

- Vacancy Credits: 6 were processed for a total of \$475.00 in April.
- <u>Credit cards/eChecks:</u> 945 payments totaling \$48,864.05 were collected in April. 2 payments received at the counter, 78 by voice response system, and 865 on-line.
- Automatic Payments: 2,086 customer accounts are signed up. Received \$82,451.97 or approximately 15.0% of monthly billing.

OPERATIONAL ACTIVITIES

• We met all permit parameters this month.

• The treatment facility averaged 97% BOD removal and 98% Total Suspended Solids Removal during the month with a requirement of no less than 85% removal for each.

• The facility electrical consumption (based on meter readings) for April 2020, was 176,000 KWHRS with a total Effluent flow of 104.85 million gallons all of which went to the South Umpqua River (Outfall 001). The April 2019 electrical consumption was 242,000 with a total

Effluent flow of 187.11 million gallons all of which went to Outfall 001 (South Umpqua River).
Preparations were made at a biosolids site for May application. We repaired the fence and installed the piezometers at the Larson site.

Semiannual influent and effluent metals testing results were within limits.

Quarterly biosolids samples were sent to the outside lab for metals and nutrient testing.

PRETREATMENT ACTIVITIES

The following pretreatment inspections were completed in April:

- Taco Bell: Tank was full. Called manager and was told they would get paperwork done to do the pumping. We will do a follow-up inspection in May.
- Rose Haven Nursing Home: Tank was full. Called Maintenance Manager and he will call a
 pumper to get unit serviced. We will do a follow-up inspection in May.
- Abby's Legendary Pizza (Stephens St.): Discharge at manhole looked good.
- Little Caesars Pizza: Used push camera and found clean-out to be satisfactory.
- *Umpqua Dairy:* Their discharge was within the pH limits and their pH meter tested Ok to a known value. The Dairy is updating their slug control plan in case of an accidental spill.

NATURAL TREATMENT SYSTEM (NTS)

- Preparations are being made to start-up the NTS for summer mode of operation.
- Numerous repairs were completed on HDPE piping that had been cut to allow access for downed tree removal.

MAINTENANCE ACTIVITIES

MAINTENANCE

- There was 1 call out for an influent pump failure for the month at the plant.
- Replaced the main slide valve for the plant Airdryer.
- Rebuilt both RAS gate gear boxes with new bearings and seals.
- Tightened up the oil tube and resealed the tension bearing for the #3 Biofilter Pump.
- Repaired the discharge solenoid for the plant Airdryer.
- Rebuilt the discharge valve for the #2 Primary Sludge Pumps.
- Replaced the Primary Samplers controller unit.
- Replumbed the Hot water recirculation pump to be able to bleed the air from the pump.
- Replaced the lower bearing unit for the Cyclone Grit Removal Mechanism.
- Repaired the spray bar header for the Irrigation pond.
- Replaced the oil sending unit for the Highland Generator.
- Installed the new #2 Biofilter Pump from a 6 MGD pump to a 9 MGD pump
- Worked 212 hours on preventative maintenance task and 55 hours on corrective maintenance tasks.

LABORATORY ACTIVITIES

- We are in our normal winter testing which requires: BOD's 3 times a week, TSS 3 times a week, pH daily, Chlorine Residual Daily average, Ammonia once a week, E. Coli 3 times a week.
- 106 permit tests were ran during the month.
- On 04/15/20, a lab water sample was collected. Sample was shipped to NRC for testing.
- Ran all nutrient curves and Method Detection Limits for summer testing.
- Calibrated Eureka probes and conducted test run to begin summer mode of operation.
 Downloaded data and recalibrated probes for deployment.

PERSONNEL/COMMUNITY SERVICE ACTIVITIES

Nothing to report.

UPCOMING EVENTS

OPERATIONS/NTS:

- Repairs to sprinkler rods and supply lines as flow in the zones continues to increase.
- Clarifiers will be taken out of service as flows to the facility recede.
- Biosolids application will ramp up as weather permits and land becomes available.

MAINTENANCE:

- Work on replacing the HMI for the SCADA system
- Rebuild Highland Pump #2
- Rebuild the check valve for the #1 Winchester station pump.


Influent TSS/BOD and Effluent Flow Graphs


