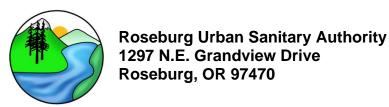

General Managers Report

Hooker Road Rehabilitation Project

The contractor continued work on the project. The contractor installed approximately 578' of 4" laterals, 474' of 2" pressure sewer, 2 private individual pump stations. The contractor has also been resurfacing the trench sections. Cradar has summitted pay request #4 in the total amount of \$234,693.88 with \$11,734.69 withheld in retainage for a payment #4 in the amount of \$222,959.19. Rob Lee, the Engineer of Record, has reviewed the data comprising the Application for Payment and recommends paying Pay Estimate #4 as submitted.

Staff has reviewed Pay Estimate #4 we concur with the Engineer and would recommend that the Board approve payment of Pay Estimate #4 in the amount of \$222,959.19.

Rogers Engineering is currently working on the specifications and plans for the chemical feed building.

Results of the Roseburg Urban Sanitary Authority Staff Questionnaire

Executive Staff developed a questionnaire to gauge the employment satisfaction of our employees. I have included the results of the questionnaire for your information.

This is the first time we have used an anonymous method of measuring the staff work experience. 64.2 percent of the employees are satisfied or very satisfied with the organization's employees experience.

50 percent of the employees are slightly likely to not likely at all to change employers.

There are observations and suggestions of improvement that I will be looking at to improve the employee work experience.

Longevity Pay and Extended Merit Pay

Staff presented the proposed Longevity Pay and Extended Merit Pay proposal. To retain our employees this proposal will reward employee for years of service as well as provide a merit pay bonus for those employees that have reached the top step in the pay scale for their position if there is not any opportunity for the employee to be promoted to another position.

Hooker Road Rehabilitation Project

The contractor continued work on the project. The contractor installed 21 cleanouts, 1 private individual pump stations. The contractor has also been resurfacing the trench sections and landscape restoration.

Cradar has summitted pay request #5 in the total amount of \$87,759.76 with \$4,387.99 withheld in retainage for a payment #5 in the amount of \$83,371.77.

Rob Lee, the Engineer of Record, has reviewed the data comprising the Application for Payment and recommends paying Pay Estimate #5 as submitted.

Staff has reviewed Pay Estimate #5 we concur with the Engineer and would recommend that the Board approve payment of Pay Estimate #5 in the amount of \$83,371.77.

Douglas Avenue Project

The City and RUSA have submitted the Douglas Avenue project as part of a list of projects for consideration in the American Rescue Plan Act for funding. The project currently has not been scheduled for bidding and subsequent construction at this time.

COLLECTION DEPARTMENT:

- Completed 22 work orders.
- Completed CCTV and cleaning of 10,296 feet or 1.95 miles of mainline.
- Completed end-of-warranty CCTV of 674 feet of mainline.
- Completed cleaning of the WWTF storm sewer.
- Completed 32 manhole inspections.
- Completed 4 service taps.
- Completed monthly trouble spot inspections.
- Completed quarterly vector control.
- Completed 210 underground utility locate requests.
- Cleaned debris from jail manhole 3 times.

ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT:

- Issued 12 permits and completed 15 inspections.
- Hooker Road project still underway, 1 private lift stations installed, Install 21 Cleanouts, Various surface restoration. Waiting on T liner, Manhole Liner Subcontractor, Electrician and Plumbers. Project on Hold until subcontractors can begin work.
- FOG Report:

FINANCE DEPARTMENT:

- Vacancy Credits: 6 were processed for a total of \$1,049.65 in October.
- <u>Credit cards/eChecks:</u> 1139 payments totaling \$60,531.05 or approximately 10.7% of monthly billing was collected in October. 111 payments were received by voice response system, 2 payments received at the counter and 1026 on-line.
- Automatic Payments: 2,146 customer accounts are signed up. Received \$95,001.62 or approximately 16.8% of monthly billing.

OPERATIONAL ACTIVITIES

• We met all permit parameters this month.

- The treatment facility averaged 98% CBOD removal and 96% Total Suspended Solids Removal during the month with a requirement of no less than 85% removal for each.
- The facility electrical consumption (based on meter readings) for October 2021, was 248,000 KWHRS with a total Effluent flow of 88.99 million gallons all of which went to the NTS at Outfall 002. The October 2020 electrical consumption was 222,000 with a total Effluent flow of 82.78 million gallons all of which went to the NTS at Outfall 002.
- Umpqua Dairy requested to release dairy whey until they can replace a piece of equipment.
- Quarterly Biosolids samples were sent to a lab for analysis.

PRETREATMENT ACTIVITIES

- The following pretreatment inspections were completed in October:
- Umpqua Dairy: The semi-annual inspection found that their discharge was within the limits measuring with our pH meter. They needed to recalibrate their pH meter in the mix tank and increase the frequency of calibration, this was agreed to with their supervisor.
- FCC Furniture: They discharge was sampled and analysis is pending for metals and cyanide, their pH was Ok.
- Veterans Administration Complex: We found their grease interceptor too full (75%) using the sludge judge tool and they were notified and agreed to pump. We did do a follow up to show their staff how we measure the tank contents. They had their tank pumped in October.
- Renards Deli: It was found that their discharge was Ok using the push camera. The Human Bean on the same discharge line is still discharging a lot of FOG (no interceptor).
- Carl's Jr: Their discharge in the clean out showed a lot of FOG build up. Contacted the manager, who will contact the maintenance person regarding pumping. Will contact them next month.
- Sizzler: We measured their tank with the sludge judge and found that they did pump their tank.
- Colony Market/Bluebird Pizza: Their discharge at the clean out looked Ok.

NATURAL TREATMENT SYSTEM (NTS)

- Repaired 121 sprinklers at the NTS.
- Flows at the SW5 have increased due to cooler wet weather.

• Chad Furlong brought sheep into the NTS at the end of October.

LIFT STATIONS

- Total Flow from all Lift Stations for the month 42 Million Gallons
- Average Daily Flow from all Lift Stations per day 1.5 Million Gallons

MAINTENANCE ACTIVITIES

- Replaced the level sensor for the NTS pond level.
- Replaced the old Missions unit with an upgraded MyDro unit for the Loma Vista station.
- Replaced the old Missions unit with an upgraded MyDro unit for the North Bank station.
- Replaced the old Missions unit with an upgraded MyDro unit for the Wilbur#1 station.
- Replaced the old Missions unit with an upgraded MyDro unit for the Wilbur#2 station.
- Replaced the refrigerator for the Lab.
- Replaced the digester gas valve for the #1 Boiler.
- Replaced the Minimum pressure check valve for the #1 Plant Air Compressor.
- Replaced all the light bulbs with LED bulbs in the Gas Compressor Room.
- Replaced the check valve body for the discharge on the #2 Primary Sludge Pump.
- Replaced 188 sprinklers at the NTS.

LABORATORY ACTIVITIES

- We are in our normal summer testing which requires: CBOD's 3 times a week, TSS 3 times a week, pH daily, Chlorine Residual Daily average, Ammonia 3 times week, E. Coli 3 times a week, Nitrate once a week, TKN once a week, and Total Phosphorus once a week.
- The Eureka probes are placed in SW1, SW5, and SW6, to continuously monitor pH, Temp., and D.O.
- Also included for the summer is Total Phosphorus (PO4) for the NTS, which is sampled at SW1, SW5, and SW6 once a week and once a month at MW1.
- Ammonia is tested for at SW5 once a month.
- When discharging from the pond we sample daily for PO4 at SW5.
- Number of Tests for permit: 122
- Eureka probes were downloaded, calibrated and deployed at SW1, SW6, and SW5, on October 5th.
- On October 27th lab water was sampled and sent out to NRC.

BIOSOLIDS

- Biosolids were hauled out in liquid and dewatered form to the Lookingglass area.
- We have been going through a weekly soils class (zoom) put on by Northwest Biosolids.

UPCOMING EVENTS

OPERATIONS/NTS:

• We will be shutting the NTS down for the season.

MAINTENANCE:

- Evaluate and Plan for Bisulfite Building Penetrations and Loads.
- Replace all the Mission units with upgraded units.
- Construct rigid mounts for the Auger Conveying system.

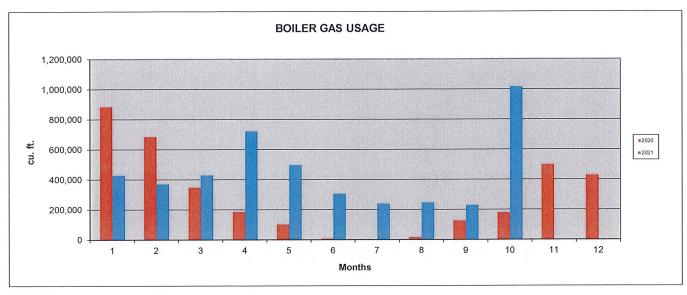

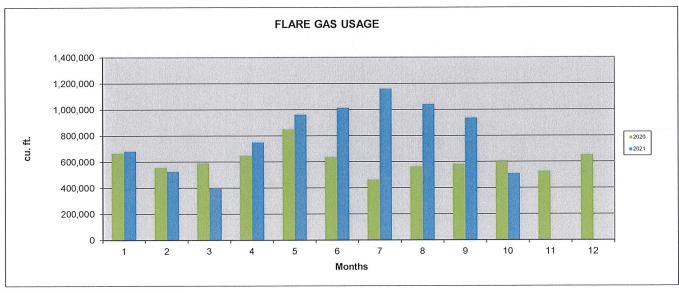
Influent TSS/BOD and Effluent Flow Graphs

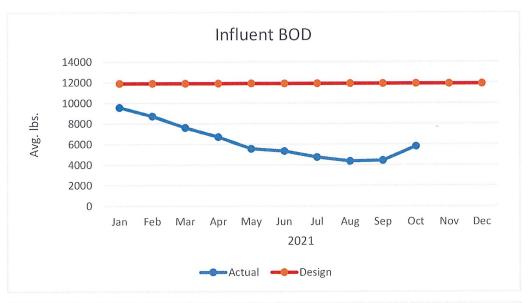

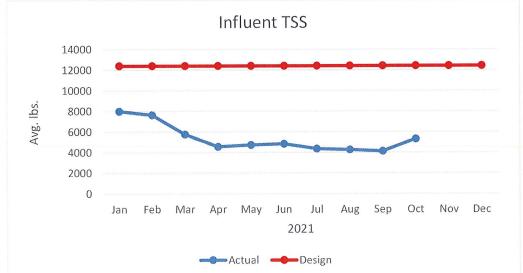

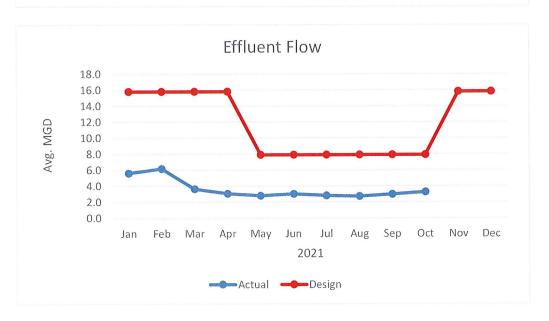
